

## Eighth Grade Picnic Permission Form

### ***ALL SCHOOL RULES APPLY, WITH A FEW EXCEPTIONS***

**You must be in dress code** – in other words, appropriate shorts/shirts for the morning and after we return. Everyone must wear shoes or sandals at all times in the park, unless swimming. Swimsuits must be worn under your regular clothing while at school in the morning and afternoon if you are planning on swimming.

It is strongly recommended you protect yourself against sunburn. **YOU CAN GET SUNBURNED EVEN ON A CLOUDY DAY!** Hats, sunglasses, long-sleeved shirts and sunscreen should be packed and used.

Students may bring cameras, iPods, or other electronics. **However, you are responsible** for any items damaged, lost, or stolen. Leave the squirt/water guns and silly string at home. You may bring candy and snacks, but keep it packed until you arrive at the park. **No skateboards.**

If you want to play basketball, wear soft-soled shoes.

2 slices of pizza, a drink, and a dessert will be provided to each student. Parents can deliver food to the park pavilion. **Food delivery should occur around 12:00 if at all possible and parents must bring the food!** We must adhere to these rules – no Pizza Hut, etc. deliveries allowed.

Misbehavior or violation of school or park rules can result in your being sent back to school immediately. The lifeguards will enforce regular pool rules. No cutoffs shorts are allowed in the water. No running in the pool area, no food or gum in the pool area, no horseplay. ***Don't forget your towel!***

On picnic day, come prepared to go on the picnic even if it looks like rain. Many times the weather clears up as we leave for the park. On the other hand, if the weather is rainy, we need to be dressed and prepared for a day of classes. In this unfortunate circumstance, we will not be able to reschedule.
